This is the admission centre that oversees all university admissions across the ACT and NSW. In order to gain entry into university in the ACT / NSW students will need to apply via UAC. Other admission centres will be discussed as part of this session as well if students are looking to study in other states. During Week 2 parents will be emailed the information discussed at the meeting so they too have all of the information to support their child.

In early August students will receive a UAC pin number via their school email. This is a 4 digit pin that they need to keep in a safe place in order to apply and manage their application.

#### **LEARN TO BE A BARTENDER**

This is a five session (one evening a week: 5.30pm till 9.30pm) program of mostly development of practical bartending skills.

CIT Reid

Location: Reid - Express Bar- Room Number: K220

Starts on Monday 6th August 2018 and runs till Monday 3rd September 2018

The course is designed to provide training for people who would like to seek bartending

positions in restaurants, nightclubs, cafes, hotels, taverns and clubs.

The Bar Service course will provide practical skills including bar opening/closing procedures, preparation of mixed drinks (such as bourbon and coke, scotch and dry, gin and tonic, tequila and lemonade etc.) basic cocktail making skills, garnish preparation, beer pouring from the beer taps, hot drinks (chai Lattes, hot chocolates etc.) drink waiting, cashiering and aspects of customer service. The course also includes an ACT Provide Responsible Service of Alcohol Statement.

The course fee for Australian citizens and permanent residents is \$215. Fees may be lower for people who already have a current ACT Provide Responsible Service of Alcohol Statement or other subjects from this course & for those who are already studying at CIT this semester. Eligible Centrelink clients might also receive a discount.
