**1. CIT Statement of Attainment - Aged Care/ Disability/ Children's Services**

This program covers the competencies common to each of the above areas, before deciding which industry to pursue. A Certificate III can be completed the following year. This course will assist you to gain an apprenticeship in any of the above areas and with entry to Nursing at CIT.

**2. CIT – Fashion Illustration Unit**

This short course will provide students interested in pursuing a career in Fashion an opportunity to develop their fashion illustration skills.

**3. CIT – Certificate IV Business Units**

If you are considering a career in Business, the following Certificate IV units are being offered to colleges for the first time by CIT.
