

Course Title: AGRICULTURE (T/A)

This practical course helps students understand the principles of Agriculture through involvement in theory and applied classes. Students do not need prior learning in Agriculture but should have an interest in living things. Concepts developed in the classroom are applied in the College Agriculture plot. Students grow vegetables and propagate other plants in their own plots and in the greenhouse, whilst they learn animal care and handling whilst managing the College's small poultry flock
